

Intensive German/integration courses at the Hebebühne Association for persons entitled to asylum and subsidiary protection with 100 % assumption of costs by the Austrian Integration Fund (ÖIF).

The Hebebühne Association offers German/integration courses for the following proficiency levels: A1, A2, B1, B2.

The courses normally last 9 weeks and comprise approximately 12 hours (= 14 lesson units à 45 min.) per week for all levels.

4 course periods

- 1st period: Begins January
- 2nd period: Begins April
- 3rd period: Begins July
- 4th period: Begins October

Course dates

3-4 times per week, each consisting of 4 hours

Depending on the level: A1 mornings, A2/B1 afternoons, B2 evenings.

Courses begin in the first month of the respective course periods stated.

Number of participants

Maximum 14 persons per course

Course costs

€ 750.00 (for 80% attendance the ÖIF sponsors the course costs for asylum seekers 100%, costs are to be borne by participants themselves if attendance is less than 80%. (ÖIF sponsoring agreement conditions))

€ 130.00 examination fee for a voluntary examination with official certificate from the ÖIF.



Course registration steps

1. Send us a registration form (via mail or post) – available for download from the home page or available from office@hebebuehne.at.
You are more likely to get a place on a course if you **send us a copy of your convention passport or the blue/grey card at the same time** (see upper field).
 2. We send you confirmation of your registration by post.
 3. We send you a cost quotation by post.
 4. Arrange an appointment with the ÖIF regarding funding: At least three weeks prior to the start of the course
 5. Attend in person taking your cost quotation, confirmation of registration, Meldezettel and social security number with you.
 6. You will then receive further information on the course from us via email (documents, organisation info, etc.).
- **Points 3 and 4 do not apply to integration courses and self-funders.**
